Artcore is looking for experienced artists to deliver a block of 5 sessions for Art Enhancing Life education and learning programme.

We support artists, expose the creative process, and engage new audiences with visual art. We achieve this by delivering an exciting and varied programme of exhibitions, off-site projects and participation events. Our aim is to make the appreciation and creation of art a more inclusive activity. It is an ethos we have been adhering to for nearly 20 years.

We are seeking expressions of interest from experienced artists, facilitators and workshop leaders to help us deliver 5 block session projects for *Art Enhancing Life*.

Art Enhancing Life Education and Learning help address issues faced by young people including those who have been excluded from school or are at risk of anti-social behaviour. Artcore intends to use Art activities in a way to reach identified target groups, giving them the opportunity to experience the positive benefits of art. **These sessions are held on Fridays during term time (4.45pm - 6.45pm).**

We would like to hear from artists working in the following, but not limited to:

- Photography
- Sculpture and Installation Art
- 2D Animation
- Video (and new media art)

With a specific focus on Science and Nature.

You must be able to demonstrate how you could use digital media to engage young and support their learning. We envisage that this will be a collaborative project, whereby young will act as curators or facilitators of their own learning. Thus, we mean that the artists must be willing to be flexible and adaptable to the young's needs.

- Driving license and access to a car would be desirable but not essential

Artcore will supply equipment and materials, subject to agreement with the relevant member of the team.
